Survey to gauge desires wanted in community

Boise Young Professionals is asking young workers in the region to complete an online **survey** about what they want most in their communities.


The group wants people, ages 20-40, to complete the survey to help inform community leaders about what it takes to attract and retain young professionals.


The survey focuses on seven topics: learning, earning, after hours, around town, social capital, cost of lifestyle and vitality.

The 40-question survey, administered by Next Generation Consulting, should take about 15 minutes and must be completed by May 12. Responses will be kept anonymous, though overall results will be shared with the Boise Metro Chamber of Commerce, the City of Boise and other chambers.

The group will release the results at Boise Mayor Dave Bieter's "Unplugged" event at the Basque Center on May 28.
